Year 5 trip to the Thinktank Science Museum

As part of our next Science topic on Earth and Space, we have arranged a trip to the Thinktank Science Museum in Birmingham on Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November. During the day, we will explore the museum’s many galleries and visit the planetarium to take part in a workshop where the children will learn about the stars and constellations and discover how to spot planets in the sky. This trip will both enhance the children’s learning and reward their hard work throughout the topic.

We will be leaving school at 9 a.m. and arrive back at approximately 3.20 p.m. (depending on the traffic). Please make sure your child arrives promptly at the start of the day so they can be registered prior to leaving to avoid a delay.

Children should wear school uniform as normal. They will need to bring their packed lunch in a labelled plastic bag (that can be disposed of after they have eaten their lunch) and an extra drink of water. Free school lunches will be provided for the children who normally have them. Can we ask that where your child normally has a free school meal, a packed lunch is ordered for this day please. They can also bring up to £5 to spend in the souvenir shop.

We are requesting a parental contribution of £26.60 per child towards the trip. Please sign the slip below and return it to your child’s class teacher. Payment for the trip can be made electronically via My Child At School app.

Please note that unless sufficient monies are received to make the trip viable, it may be necessary to cancel the visit.
